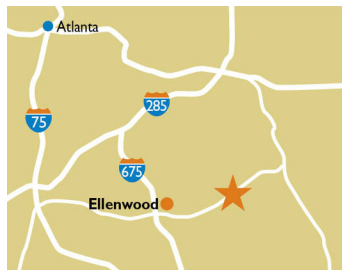
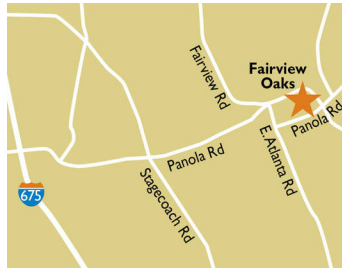

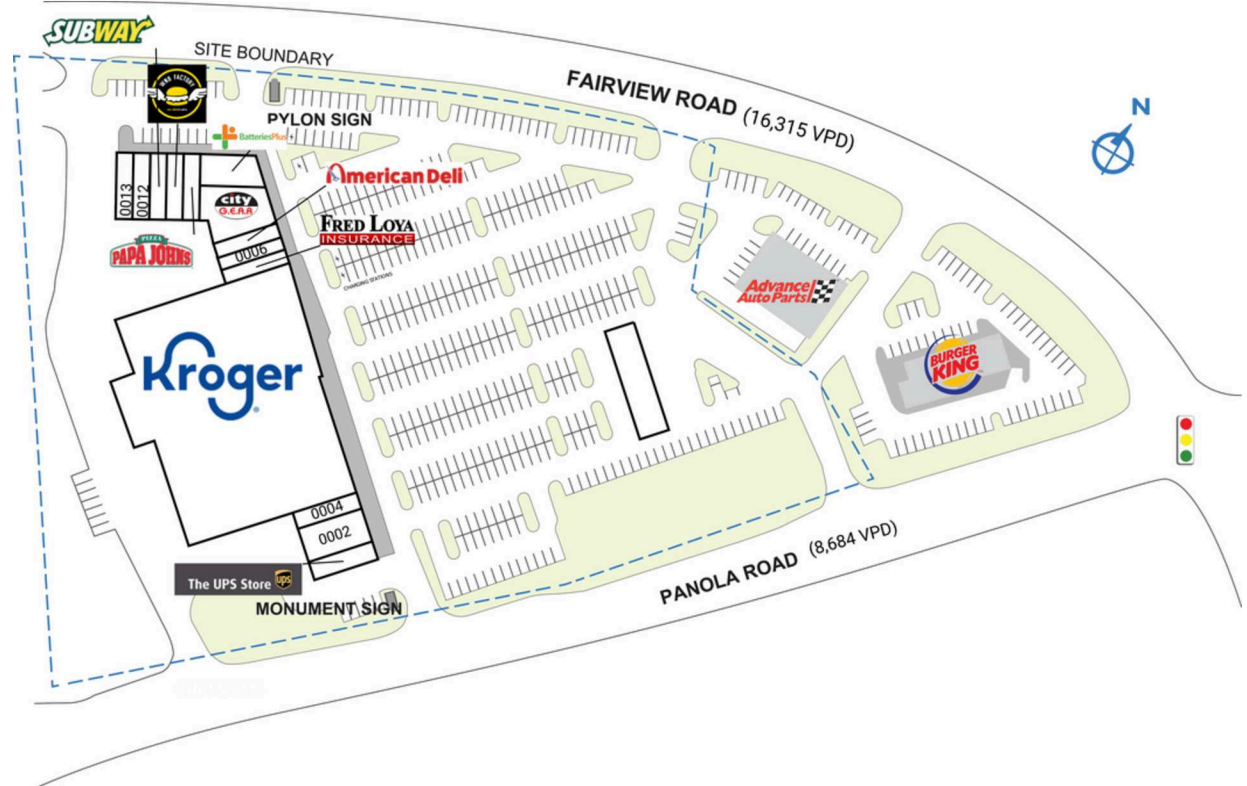
PROPERTY HIGHLIGHTS
